As we quickly approach the end of term, can I please remind parents of all the Christmas events taking place at the academy in the last week. If you haven't received the dates please contact the office for all the details.

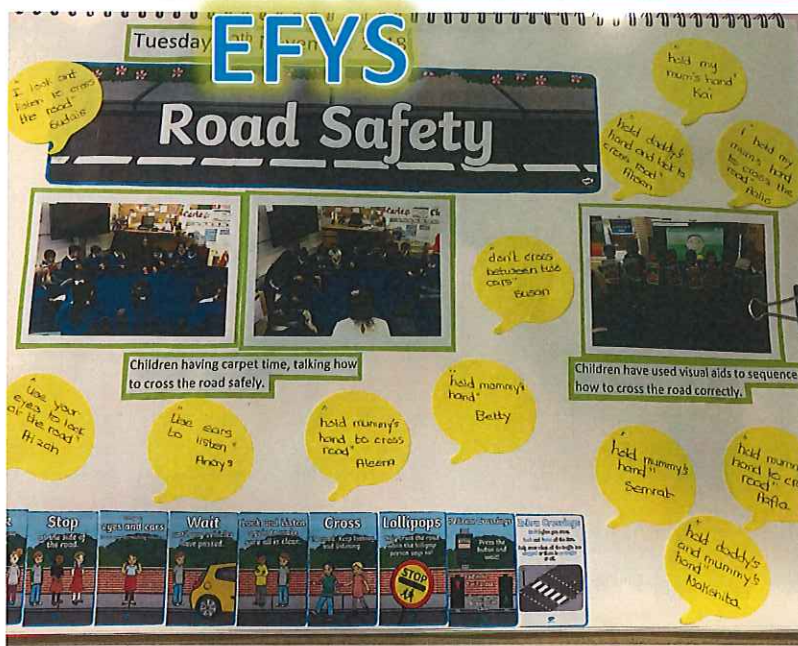
