A region is a specific area that has common natural or artificial features. It could be based on language, government, religion, type of flora and fauna or climate. Regions are basic units of geography



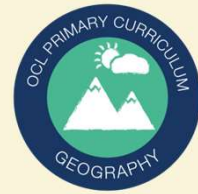
Cities

- It is in a tropical climate zone



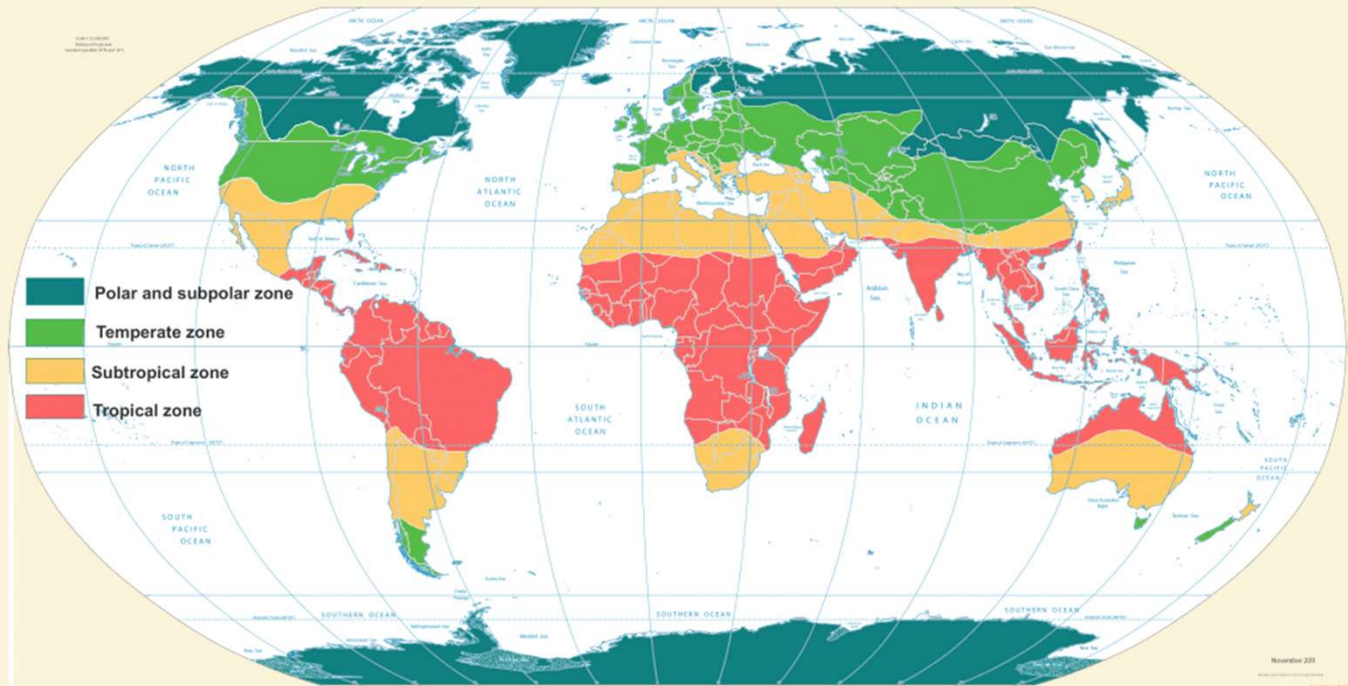


Cities of the UK

Previous learning

- Know the town/ city they live in and what country this is in eg Bristol, England
- Know important human and physical features of their town/ city eg landmarks, areas on interests, parks, rivers, city centre, tourist attractions etc (these will be specific to your area)
- Know information about the important human and physical features of their town/ city (eg how many visitors they have per year, when it was built, what value it adds to the city)
- Be able to ask questions to find out what people's opinions are of their town city (through fieldwork) eg What is the best thing about living in Bristol? What is the worst thing about living in Bristol?
- Know what continent Uganda is in (Africa)
- Know important facts about Uganda eg it's flag, the capital city- Kampala, it's famous lake- Lake Victoria, it's native animals- hippo, crocodile, chimpanzees, it's language- Luganda, weather- hot, dry climate.
- Children to sort information learnt about Uganda into human and physical features eg human feature- flag, capital city, language. Physical features- lake victoria, weather, native animals.
- Place their home town/ city on a map of the UK
- Place their home town/ city on a map of the world
- Place Uganda on a map of the world

Core learning

- Children will know what a 'region' in geography is eg *A region is a specific area that has common features. A region may have common natural or artificial features. A region can be based on language, government, religion, type of flora and fauna or climate. Regions are the basic units of geography.*
- Children will be able to identify regions of the UK eg *North West, South East, Greater London etc*
- Children will know there are many cities (other than the capital cities) in the UK eg *Newcastle, Cambridge, Birmingham etc*
- Children will know the climate zones of the world (*artic, temperate, tropical, desert*)
- Know key features of the artic, temperate and tropical climate zones eg *what the weather is like, what seasons they experience, what can live in such climates, which countries experience each climate*
- Know where Mozambique is in the world (*South East Coast of Africa*)
- Know the physical features of Mozambique eg *located on the equator, Zambezi river is it's longest river, Mount Binga is it's highest mountain, it has a tropical climate with two seasons, it's grows cashew nuts- this is it's largest export*
- Know the human features of Mozambique eg *the main language is Portuguese, the currency is Mozambique metical (MZM), Maputo is the capital city, common dwellings include rural huts*
- Children will be able to locate regions of the UK on a map eg *North West, South East, Greater London etc*
- Children will be able to locate cities of the UK on a map eg *Newcastle, Cambridge, Birmingham etc*
- Locate Mozambique on a World Map
- Locate climate zones on a world map (*artic, temperate, tropical, desert*)
