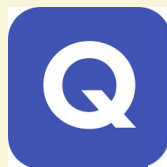

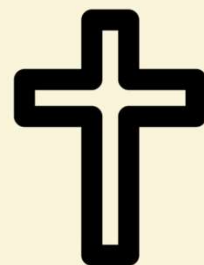

Previous learning

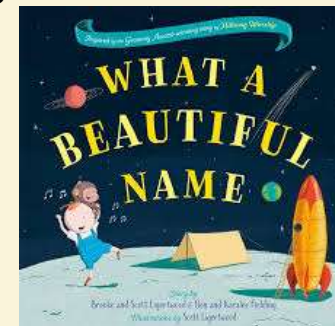
- Show sensitivity to their own and other's needs.
