

Curriculum Overview for Year 1

English

Writing

- We will be looking at:
- saying a sentence before writing it down
- Using capital letters, finger spaces and a full stop
- Using adjectives in your work
- Being able to sequence a story and recall it accurately

Reading

- using phonics to decode the words
- be able to say what happened in the story
- be able to speak about the main character(s) in the story

Handwriting

We are learning: how to write on the line.

- how to write on the line
- how to use capital letters
- using full stops
- using finger spaces
- how to present out work neatly and with pride

Mathematics

- Count, read and write numbers to 20 in numerals
- Identify numbers to 20
- Given a number, identify one more, ones less
- Count, read and write number to 20 (as words)
- Count to 20 backwards and forwards beginning with 0 or any given number
- Practice ordering e.g. first, second, third, fourth
- Counting in multiples of 2's, 5's and 10's
- Make connections between arrays, number patterns and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's
- Understand division through sharing small quantities

Art & Design & Technology

We will be learning how to:

- Design and create animal pictures based on different artists work.
- Using different artistic skills including painting, printing and pattern.

Music

We will be:

- Tapping out a variety of rhythms.
- Learning different animal songs.

PE

Learn how to follow instructions.
Learn how to move safely during an active lesson.
Stay hydrated during the lesson.
Understand why it is important to have regular exercise.
Practicing basic movements including skipping and hopping.

RE

Children will be learning about the importance of taking care of each other and how different faiths teach this.
