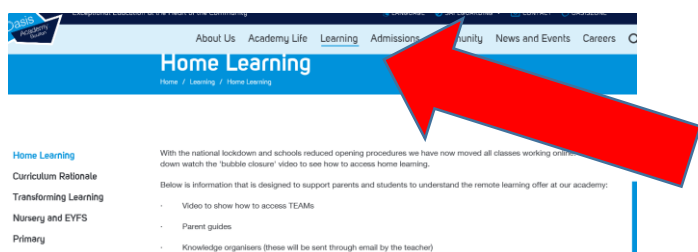

What happens if school is open and my child must self-isolate?



If your child must self-isolate, they will access their online learning by clicking on the interactive timetable on the academy website. The same procedures apply for sending work to the class teacher via email.

1. To access 'Microsoft Teams':



2. Login to Microsoft Teams:

- All live sessions will be recorded
- Cameras must be turned on and kept on during the lesson
- Children should NOT record the lesson and do not take photographs of the screen for personal use or for social media
- Chat function has been disabled so children will need to use the hands up function to communicate with the teacher
- Find a quiet area and ask everyone else to remain quiet during your lesson
- Use headphones/earphones if possible to help you to concentrate
- A parent must be nearby you during the lesson
- Mute your microphone when the lesson starts
- Remain in the lesson for the whole time
- Speak kindly and appropriately verbally
- Behave as you would be expected to in a lesson at school

- Listen carefully to your teacher
- Only speak when your teacher asks you to
- Contribute to the lesson and ask questions like you normally would
- Sit sensibly during the live lesson
- Complete the tasks that your teacher gives you



How does my child access the learning in the timetable?

Below are more details about how to access each subject in your child's timetable:

NB If your child is in Reception, they will need their log in details for Numbot .Please email your child's class teacher if you need to know these.

Monday to Friday	9.30 am 'Live' check in session with teacher	Children can log into the class Teams and click on the scheduled meeting that will be in the general channel. If children want to access a live stream with their sibling, they can as long as they access one live session a day with their teacher/class.

		
Mon - Thurs	<i>Literacy 10 am</i>	<p>At 10am click on the pre-recorded Literacy lesson stream in Teams in the literacy channel or the timetable. This will take you to your child's learning for the day.</p> <p>Complete the Microsoft forms quiz and email it to your teacher as directed.</p>
	<i>Phonics play 10.45am</i>	<p>At 10.45am click on link to play a phonics game.</p>
	<i>Maths 11.00am</i>	<p>At 11 am- click on the pre-recorded maths lesson stream in Teams in the Maths channel or the timetable. This will take you to your child's learning for the day.</p> <p>Complete the Microsoft forms quiz and email it to your teacher as directed.</p>
	<i>Phonics 11.45</i>	<p>At 11 am- click on the pre-recorded Phonics lesson steam in Teams in the Phonics channel or on the timetable. This will take you to your child's learning for the day.</p> <p>Complete the Microsoft forms quiz and email it to your teacher as directed</p>
	<i>12-12.45pm LUNCH BREAK</i>	<p>Remember to eat a healthy lunch!</p> 

	Handwriting 12.45	At 12.45 am- click on the pre-recorded lesson stream in Teams in the Handwriting channel or on the timetable. This will take you to your child's learning for the day. Email any photographs of your work to your teacher as directed.
	Independent learning- Reading 1.15pm	At 1.15pm click on the link on the timetable that takes you to the book to read.
	Numbots Maths games 1.45	Click on the link that takes your child to Numbots.
	LIVE story time with class teacher 2.30-3pm	Children can log into the class Teams and click on the scheduled meeting that will be in the general channel. If children want to access a live stream with their sibling, they can as long as they access one live session a day with their teacher/class.
Friday	Family Learning Day ALL DAY	Click on the links for each session on the timetable.

*Children need to send their completed work to their class teacher daily.

Will my child need to complete work during the lesson? How will they do this?

Your child will have to complete work set by the teacher during the lesson. They will need to email their teacher a photograph of the work from each lesson and complete the quiz which can be accessed on the timetable.

Will my child need to complete homework?

Children will need to remember and apply their knowledge of phonic sounds from their phonics lessons in the week, as well as key concepts from maths and literacy. Children will also need to practise their handwriting and reading daily.

How will I know how is my child progressing?

You will receive a weekly report to show how your child has progressed during the week like the one below:
